Magill received a B.A. degree, cum laude, from St. Olaf College in Northfield, Minnesota, and a J.D. degree from the University of Minnesota Law School, where he was named a distinguished alumnus in 2005.

He is licensed to practice law in Illinois and Minnesota and admitted to practice before the United States Tax Court. He serves on the Boards of the Creator Arts Center, the Block Museum of Art, and several foundations. He and his wife reside in Winnetka, Illinois with their three children.
